LEEP PROCEDURE POST PATIENT HANDOUT

WHAT TO EXPECT POST PROCEDURE

- Patient may have small or moderate amount of discharge and bleeding as well after procedure.
 - Discharge may look brownish yellow due to the antiseptic solution that is used after the procedure on the cervix to stop the bleeding
 - Expect a small amount of bright red blood occasionally for 2 weeks
 - Expect brownish-black or watery vaginal discharge for 2-3 weeks
 - o Expect heavier menstrual periods for 2-3 cycles after having procedure
- Patient may experience some cramping or discomfort after procedure that may last for 2-3 days

POST-OP INSTRUCTIONS- Immediately after procedure

- **PAIN:** may take Ibuprofen 600 mg, 2 Extra Strength Tylenol every 8 hours, or Midol as needed for pain.
- **PERSONAL CARE:** NO douching or tampon use, sexual intercouse or swimming for 3 weeks after procedure.

PRECAUTIONS-Please call our office if you experience any of the following

- Heavy vaginal bleeding, filling a pad an hour for more than two hours consecutively.
- Severe Abdominal pain
- Foul smelling vaginal discharge in large amounts
- Chills/Fever greater than >101F or above 100.4 for 4 hours.
